I INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL FOLKLORE, CHOIRS & ORCHESTRAS WARSAW, POLAND “DANCING IN THE PHOENIX CITY” September 21 - 24, 2017.

Festival is organized by Mediteranian Organization in cooperation with local municipalities, chambers of commerce and local folklore ensemble. The festival will be covered in media by the local and international press and television. Mayor or the deputy mayor of the city of festival contestants will be honored guest of the festival, at the expense of the organizer.

Warsaw is the capital and largest city of Poland. It stands on the Vistula River in east-central Poland.

In 2012 the Economist Intelligence Unit ranked Warsaw as one of the most liveable cities in Central Europe. Today Warsaw is considered a major international tourist destination and a significant cultural, political and economic hub.

Warsaw has also been called "Eastern Europe's chic cultural capital with thriving art and club scenes and serious restaurants".

The historic city-centre of Warsaw with its picturesque Old Town in 1980 was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Warsaw provides many examples of architecture from the gothic, renaissance, baroque, neoclassical and modern periods, and around a quarter of the city is filled with luxurious parks and royal gardens.



PROGRAM

1st day – September 21 Arrival in Warsaw. Accommodation at the hotel. Free time for individual activities. Dinner. Overnight.

2nd day – September 22 Breakfast. Press conference at the press center. Free time for individual activities. Optional Warsaw city tour (Palace of Culture and Science, Łazienki Park, Sigismund's Column, Warsaw Old Town, Old Town Market Place, Warsaw etc.). Opening ceremony. Participant groups performances. Dinner. Optional night out at a local restaurant. Overnight.

3rd day – September 23 Breakfast. Info presentation at the conference hall. Optional Warsaw city cruise by boat. Participant groups performances. Closing ceremony. Dinner. Optional night out. Overnight.

4th day – September 24 Breakfast. Hotel check out and departure. End of services.
